Delhi Technological University declares first admission list

NEW DELHI: Delhi Technological University declared its first list of admissions on Tuesday for its 15 B.Tech. programmes in engineering and technology disciplines. The results are available on the DTU website www.dtuadmissions.nic.in

This year the university opted for online admissions. The university reserves 85 per cent seats for Delhi candi-

dates. A total of 1,022 seats are available to Delhi candidates including the general category, Other Backward Classes and Scheduled Tribes/Scheduled Tribes. The number of Delhi candidates who applied is 5,745. There are 181 seats in the outside Delhi category including the general, OBC and SC/ST categories for which 4,298 applications were received. Admissions are on the basis of the candidate's all-India merit rank in the All-India Engineering/Architecture Entrance Examination, 2011. DTU offers B.Tech. programmes in electronics and communication, and computer, software, information technology, mechanical, automotive, production and industrial, electrical, civil and environmental engineering as well as bio-technology, polymer science and chemical engineering technology, physics and mathematics and

computing. The candidates who figure in the first admission list should report for admission at DTU here along with original documents from Wednesday onward as per the schedule available on the website. Those who do not report for admission on the scheduled dates forfeit their right of admission and the vacant seats will be filled through the second list of admissions to be announced on July 15.
